



HISTORY OF SHELTER NOVA SCOTIA

- 1968.....The Saint Leonard's Society of Nova Scotia established
- 1984.....[Sir Sanford Fleming House](#), a halfway house for men, opens in Halifax
- 1993.....Turn Around Point Services, a halfway house for men, opens in New Minas
- 2000.....Women's halfway house opened in the basement of Sir Sanford Fleming House
- 2001.....[Barry House](#), a shelter for women experiencing homelessness, opens in Halifax
- 2005.....[Nehiley House](#), a women's halfway house, opens in Halifax
- 2007.....Turn Around Point Services closes in New Minas
- 2009.....[Metro Turning Point](#), a shelter for men experiencing homelessness, merges with Saint Leonard's Society
- 2010.....[Supportive Housing](#) program initiated
- 2011.....Saint Leonard's Society of Nova Scotia reinvents itself as Shelter Nova Scotia
- 2012.....[The Rebuilding](#), a 19-unit affordable, supportive apartment complex opens
- 2015.....Shelter Nova Scotia opens it's 6th facility, known as [Herring Cove Apartments](#)
